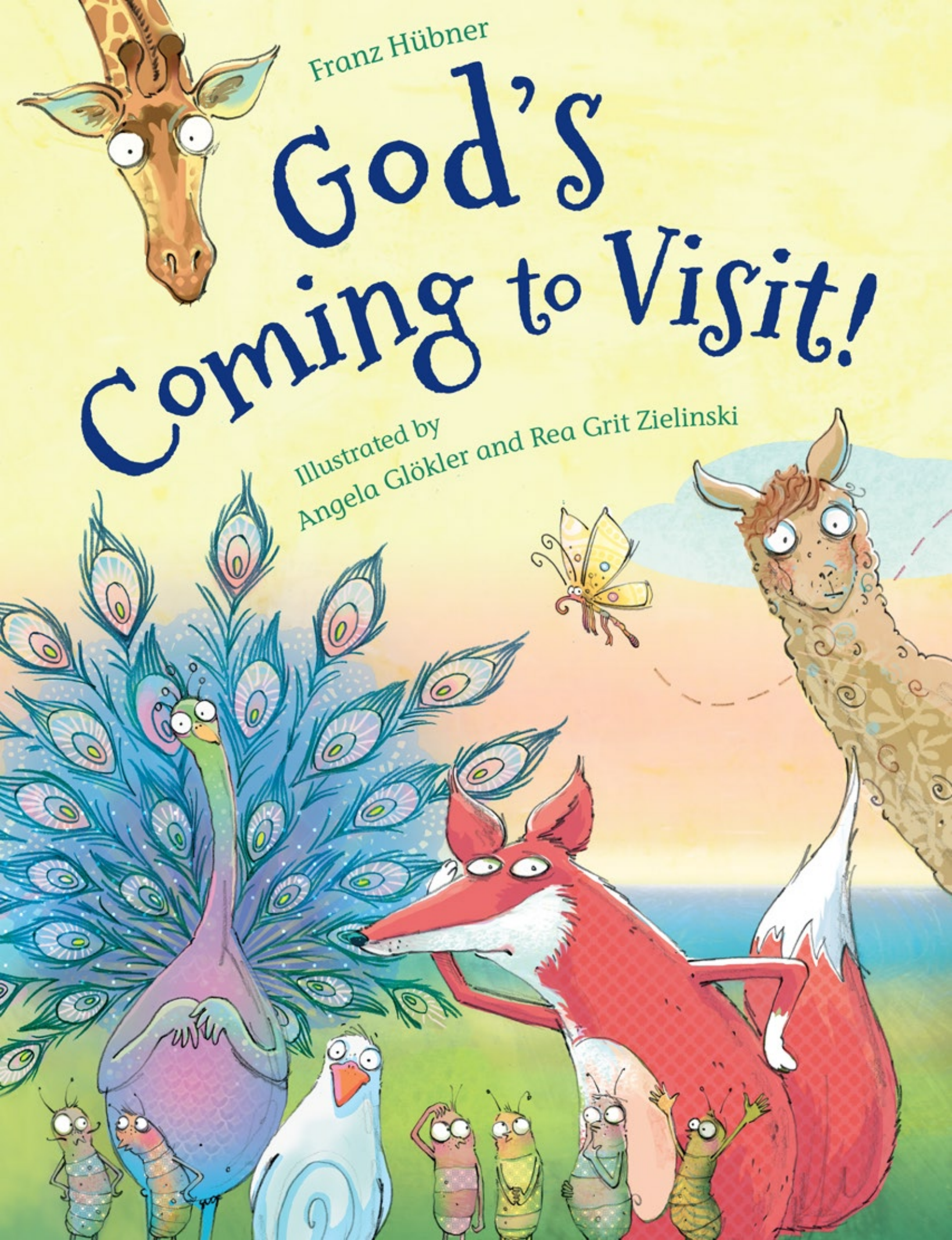

# God's Coming to Visit!

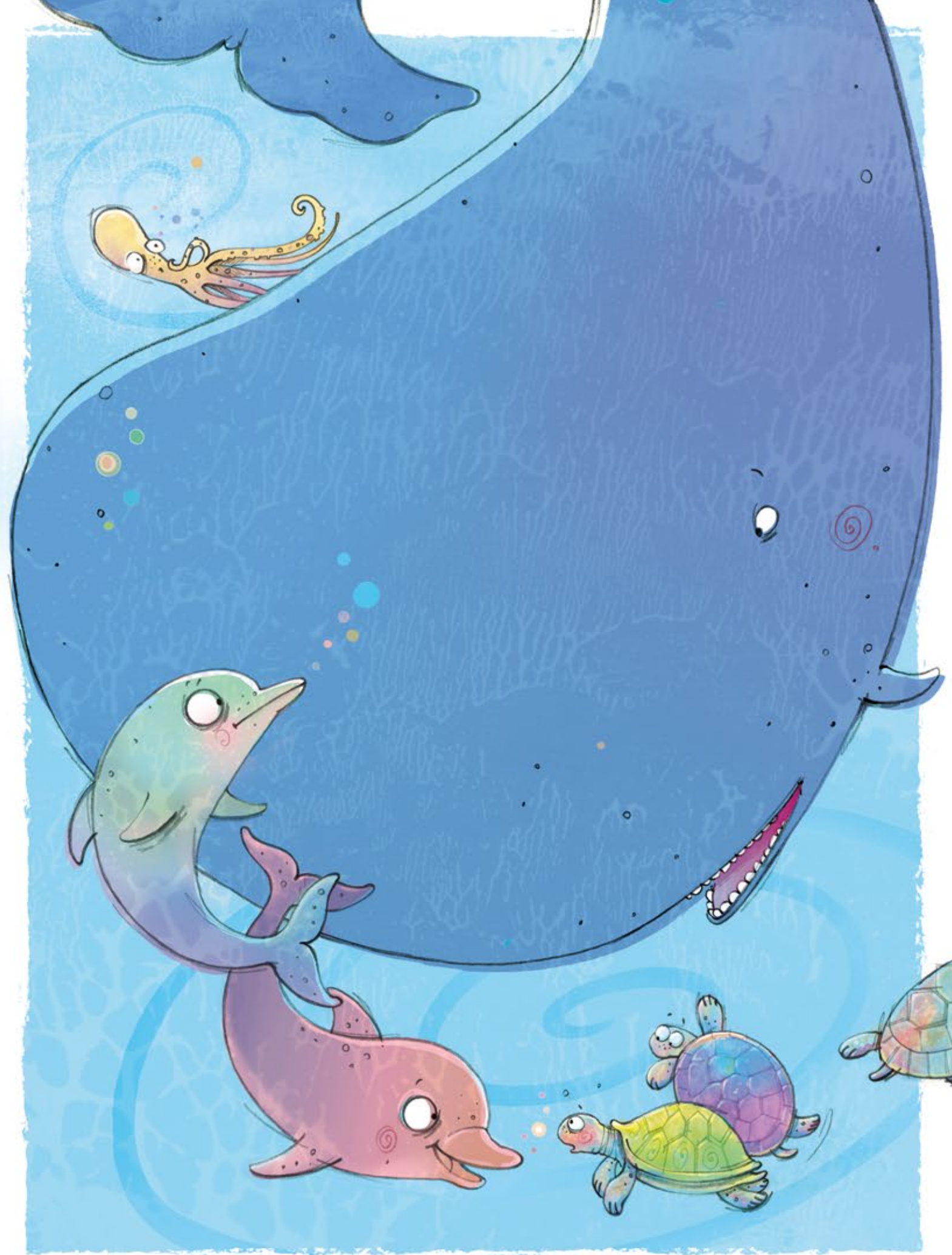

How exciting!

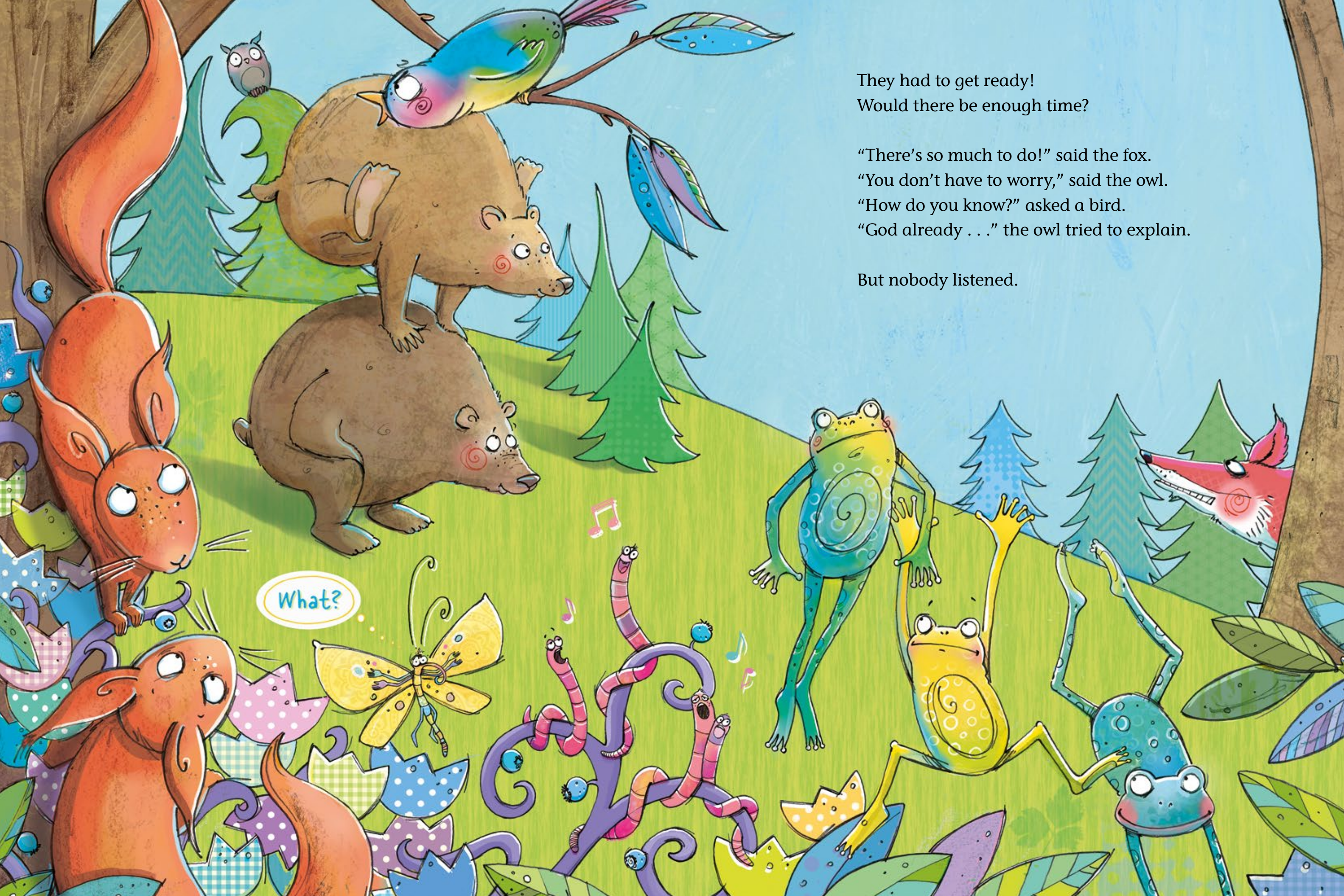
A little scary too.
